PURSUANT TO Rule 16, the Court enters the following order:

1. All parties are to meet, as required by Rule 26(f), to confer and plan the discovery process in these matters consistent with this Order.
2. The meeting shall occur during the last twenty minutes of class on March 20th.
3. With regard to discovery in these cases, the Court modifies the rules as follows:
 - a. All discovery must be completed by April 12th.
 - b. Each party is limited to three interrogatories, two categories of documents in their request for production of documents, and one deposition.
 - c. Responding parties will have four days to respond to any interrogatories or requests for production.
 - d. All deposition will take place in class on April 12th.
 - e. No other discovery will be permitted.
3. Following and as a result of the meeting, the parties shall file a Proposed Discovery Plan with the Court no later than March 23rd, addressing the following:
 - a. The sequence and timing of discovery, specifically when interrogatories and request for production will be served and answered.
 - b. Who will be deposed.

c. Any other matters set forth in Rule 26(f) the parties determine should be addressed
4. The Court will address any matters raised by the parties in their Discovery Plans during a very brief scheduling conference in class on March 27th.
