

**Fall Semester 2009 Judicial Externship
DEADLINE FOR APPLICATIONS – April 17**

The College of Law will again offer its judicial externship program during the Fall Semester 2009. Between two and seven students will be selected to participate in the four-hour judicial externship for the fall semester. The students will be to work with various state and federal courts. To participate in the program, students must be either in the second semester of their second year or in their third year of law study. Preference will be given to third-year students. Only students who have taken Criminal Procedure will be considered for the Criminal Court externships, absent exceptional circumstances.

To participate, students must be available to work at the court or on work assigned by the judge 12-14 hours per week in a minimum of 3-4 hour blocks of time. Students are also required to attend orientation classes and satisfy the administrative requirements for the course. Students who satisfy all of the requirements of the program will receive four hours of pass/fail credit.

Those interested in participating in the program during fall semester 2009 must submit an (1) updated resume and (2) a Statement of Interest to Professor White at pwhite4@utk.edu no later than Friday, April 17, at 5:00 p.m. The form for the Statement of Interest may be found at http://www.law.utk.edu/course-materials/spring2009/20092_949_White_148.pdf. Decisions will be made about selection before the completion of the registration process. Selected students must register for the course and bid the requisite number of points.
