Re: Janet D. Steiger Fellowship Project (Summer 2010)

As Chair of the ABA Section of Antitrust Law, I would like to alert you to a wonderful opportunity that is available again for up to 20 first and second year law students throughout the United States, and I would very much like your assistance in making sure that your students learn of this opportunity. The Section of Antitrust Law sponsors a summer fellowship program, named the Janet D. Steiger Fellowship Project, honoring the memory of the late Chairman of the Federal Trade Commission. Each of the 20 selected students will serve for a minimum of eight weeks in the consumer protection department of one of the participating State Attorneys General¹ during the summer of 2010:

The first five years of this project have been considered an overwhelming success by each of the Steiger Fellows and each of the participating offices of state attorneys general. Please be reminded that this project will be continued through 2010, and hopefully, beyond. Your Career Services Office will also be notified of the existence of this program.

Each selected student will receive a \$5,000 stipend for the summer (administered through the offices of the state attorneys general and subject to certain federal taxes). The program also offers a supplemental housing/travel allowance of up to \$2,000 for those students who are not living at home for the summer (administered through the American Bar Association). This supplemental allowance will not be considered until after Fellows have been selected

The application period is (November 15, 2009 until February 5, 2010). Applications will not be accepted beyond the **February 5, 2010** deadline date. Students must submit: (1) the

Keeping in mind that the needs of each State AG's office are different, following is a sampling of the types of assignments that may be encountered:

- Assist with consumer protection training
- Assist with development of consumer protection informational pamphlets
- Assist with investigations
- Assist with Investigative and litigation depositions
- Assist with preparing and responding to discovery
- Attend settlement conferences
- Conduct legal research
- Draft cease and desist agreement, briefs and legislation
- Draft civil investigative demands and subpoenas
- Draft legal memorandum and documents
- Interview witnesses and consumers
- Participate in court hearings and possibly trials
- Participate in staff meetings and strategy sessions
- Write letters to businesses that are the subject of consumer complaints

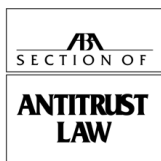
Fellowship Guidelines

Each Fellowship is part of the Consumer Protection Outreach Initiative of the ABA Section of Antitrust Law. Students will be placed in the Consumer Protection Departments of each state office and more than 50% of each student's time will be devoted to consumer protection matters. The remainder of each student's time, at the option of each state, may be devoted to antitrust matters.

In order to be eligible for a Janet D. Steiger Fellowship, applicants must currently be first or second year law students at an ABA accredited law school. Each Steiger Fellow will receive a gross stipend of \$5000 for the eight week period, and will be responsible for all taxes and other required deductions. Please note that the Project in its discretion is able to provide Steiger Fellows with limited funds (not to exceed \$ 2000) for both travel and housing where a clear need is demonstrated. Be sure to indicate whether you are requesting a travel/housing allowance. Please note that the completion of additional forms will be required if selected as a Fellow and application for travel/housing allowance is made.

Applications and all accompanying material **MUST** be **received** by **February 5, 2010**. Applications will be accepted by mail or fax at the Section of Antitrust Law (address listed above), or by email to douglasd@staff.abanet.org. An application that is incomplete or received after **February 5, 2010** will not be considered. There is no application fee.
